- Directs federal agencies to develop environmental justice strategies to help address disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects of their programs on minority and low-income populations.
- Presidential Memorandum (1994)
- Federal Interagency Working Group

What is Environmental Justice?

- EJ = <u>fair treatment</u> and <u>meaningful involvement</u> of all people regardless of race, color, national origin, or income with respect to the development, implementation and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations and policies.
 - Fair treatment means no group of people should bear a disproportionate share of the negative environmental consequences resulting from industrial, governmental and commercial operations or policies.
 - Meaningful involvement means:
 - People have an opportunity to participate in decisions about activities that may affect their environment and/or health
 - The public's contribution can influence the regulatory agency's decision
 - Community concerns will be considered in the decision making process
 - Decision makers will seek out and facilitate the involvement of those potentially affected
